can be done in any female cat from the age of 5-6 months, before she comes into season for the first time.

Why should I have my cat neutered?

1. There will be no more heat periods.
2. She will be unable to get pregnant hence no unwanted kittens.
1. The risk of her getting a potentially life-threatening uterine infection (pyometra) is removed. This is common in older cats.
2. The chances of her suffering from hormone induced mammary (breast) cancer can be reduced.

Commonly quoted reasons not to neuter your cat.

1. *“it will make my cat fat and lazy”*. Not true. Obesity is due to excessive feeding. This can be controlled.
2. *“ it will change her disposition, personality or intelligence”*. Cats personalities do not fully develop until 1 year of age. If there is a personality change after speying at an early age, it would have occurred without surgery.
3. *“she should have a litter first”*. No .There is no advantage in allowing your cat to have a litter of kittens.
4. All anaesthetics involve risks. The risk is smaller in younger fitter animals than in older cats. Anaesthetic risks have now been minimised by the use of modern drugs, techniques and equipment.
