a product licensed in that country. The DEFRA
website has links to help you find a vet local to
where you will be staying. The vet will then endorse
your pets passport allowing you to re-enter the UK.

Exotic Disease Prevention

Travelling with your pet in Europe or further afield
can lead to exposure to diseases we don't see in the
UK, in addition to rabies. There are steps you can
take to prevent problems.

To prevent heartworm make sure you worm with
milbemax before travelling and monthly whilst you
are away.

Tick-borne disease and sandfly-borne disease are
both prevalent in certain areas. These can be
prevented by using either a *scalibor collar* on your
dog or monthly applications of *advantix* which is a
spot-on preparation.

What do I need to do to get my Pet Passport?

1. Get your pet identichipped.
2. Your pet needs a rabies vaccination. (the recommendation is for young animals, less than 12 months, and older animals, more than 8 years old, to have **2 vaccinations** 3 weeks apart.)
3. We issue a Pet Passport
4. 3 weeks after vaccination your pet can travel .
5. Regular rabies booster vaccinations will be required

It is important to have your rabies booster vaccination done BEFORE the due date in the passport or you will have to repeat the whole initial process.

PETS is a process designed to alleviate the necessity for quarantine whilst maintaining the UK's rabies free status. It does not guarantee your pet entry into the country you are visiting. Well before you travel you must check the entry requirements of that country or countries.
